

## **CUSTOMERS OF WATERLOO WATER & LIGHT COMMISSION**

Waterloo Water & Light Commission has filed an application with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) to increase electric rates. The adjustment is necessary to cover increased operation and maintenance expenses that will allow the utility to continue providing reliable and quality service to our customers. Additionally, the utility has asked the Commission to set appropriate rate levels which may include raising fixed customer charges. The last electric rate increase was approved in September 2017.

The utility is requesting an overall increase of 12.29%, or \$469,329. This request is detailed in Waterloo Water & Light Commission's electric rate application submitted to the PSCW on June 10, 2020. After review, Commission staff proposed a revised increase in rates of \$425,116, or 12.31%. The actual change to individual customers will vary with electricity usage, class of service and the ultimate rates authorized by the Commission. If the application is approved by the PSCW, per staff recommendation, the average residential customer using 684 kilowatt-hours (kWh) of electricity per month will see a monthly increase of approximately \$8.02, or 10.7%.
