

SUMMER SEWER CREDITS ARE BACK



Congratulations, you've been automatically registered to receive summer sewer credits.

Sewer bills from Waterloo Utilities are based on the gallons of water used plus a monthly customer charge. In the summer months, the utility applies a summer sewer maximum to help residential customers avoid being charged for water used to water lawns and gardens, wash cars, fill pools and more.

Here is how the summer sewer maximum works:

- The billing software reviews each residential customer's water usage from October through March and calculates the average plus 20%. This average becomes the customer's maximum sewer usage for summer billing. An average of 4,000 gallons will be used for new customers.
- Summer months run approximately May 1 through Aug. 31. These bills are marked June 8, July 8, Aug. 8 and Sept. 8. During this time, residential customers pay the lesser of their actual water usage or their summer sewer maximum.

The utility will not issue credits for less than 1,000 gallons or outside the usage dates of May 1 through Aug. 31.

Portland Sanitary District does not offer summer sewer.
